President's Message

Life is hard for the people in Nicaragua, and new government rulings impose more restrictions on a regular basis. The people need our help and support more than ever, but our volunteers and partner organizations have not been deterred. They continue to work within (and sometime around) the imposed limitations. While large Eye Care Clinics are not possible within Nicaragua at this time, small clinics and eye surgeries groups continue. So with the government restrictions, how does Hopeful Ways move forward?

- 1. Continue the Nicaragua Eye Care Mission to the greatest extent possible with small scale activities.
- 2. Investigate new non-eye care opportunities to help the Nicaraguan people. One possibility is to build low-cost basic houses using a successful process developed by the nonprofit 4 Walls.
- 3. Investigate taking Eye Care Missions to other Latin American countries. We are currently working with a Lions Club in Costa Rica to make that a reality.

Free Eye Surgeries Prevent Blindness as Costs Surge

Supply shortages due to the pandemic followed by inflation has increased the cost of surgical supplies and medications. Nevertheless, Hopeful Ways has maintained the per patient cost for a cataract surgery at only \$180, which is paid by Hopeful Ways.

The Eye Care Mission continued strong during the first half of 2022. Eye care clinics were conducted to identify potential eye surgery candidates, and 26 patients from Boaco, El Sauce and Juigalpa received cataract surgery with another 35 patients on the waiting list.

surgery also had other serious eye complications. Both women required additional eye surgeries before the cataract surgery could be performed, which increased the patient costs to \$1500 and \$1800. Without the surgeries, both women would have been permanently blind. The Hopeful Ways "Gift of Sight" program stepped in and funded the multiple surgeries required for each patient. Both women are very grateful for having received the surgeries.

Finally, another 32 people have been identified as eligible for cataract surgery but are hesitant to have it performed. This type of fear is not uncommon with the poor clientele that we serve. Some of these people have never seen any doctor before in their lives, and they need to be educated on the tremendous benefits and minimal risks of the procedure.

New Initiatives

The Nicaraguan government has progressively increased restrictive policies that hamper, and in some cases prevent, nonprofits from helping the poorest people. Despite these restrictions, Hopeful Ways has continued Eye Care Clinics and eye surgery services for the poor by partnering with local Nicaraguan nonprofits.

However, Eye Care Mission teams cannot travel to Nicaragua. Therefore, Hopeful Ways must evolve and adapt to the changing social and political environments to maximize the benefits delivered to the poor. To quote Oliver Wendell Holmes: "A mind that is stretched by a new experience can never go back to its old dimensions." So Hopeful Ways is investigating new opportunities for mission teams, both within Nicaragua and in other countries. Two possible opportunities are currently being investigated:

1. Building basic housing in Nicaragua in partnership with the nonprofit 4 Walls / Curatro Paredes, which has already built 200 houses in northern Nicaragua. Each mission would complete one house and would include 4-5 Hopeful volunteers working for a week alongside 4 Walls craftsmen and the Nicaragua family receiving the house. During these missions. Hopeful Ways intends to learn the 4 Walls process and replicate it in areas of Nicaragua where Hopeful Ways currently works. This work is still possible because it doesn't require any government oversight like medical missions, it only requires a small group of mission travelers carrying minimal supplies, and it only uses local materials. The pictures depict a family's previous house and the basic house built for them.





2. Partnering with a Costa Rica Lions Club to bring an Eye Care Mission to Costa Rica. The 1 - or 2-week mission team would consist of 20–30 volunteers and be similar to the previous Hopeful Ways Nicaragua Eye Care Missions.

Bicycling to Restore Sight

The 6th annual Bicycling to Restore Sight Fundraiser will explore the Greater Niagara Peninsula in Canada, specifically around the Welland Canal connecting Lakes Erie and Ontario. The ride will be a visual journey of beauty that can only be fully appreciated without vision impairment. Cataract surgery and eyeglasses can lessen or eliminate vision impairment for many people. This event raises thousands of dollars annually to support our mission to improve and restore vision by providing free eye care services and eye surgeries to the poor.







Jim Carlins has set a goal of \$3,000 so that at least 15 needy people can have their vision restored with cataract surgery. The self-supported rider(s) on this multi-day trip pay their own expenses and carry their own clothes and supplies on their bikes. Hopeful Ways successfully launch the **Endowment Program**, which will grow and continually provide an annual infusion of funds to support mission programs. Many years or fundraising and growth will be required before it fully supports the mission, but it is off to a great start. No donation is too small to help ensure lasting support to the poor.

The Endowment Matching Funds offer is still available and has enticed some supporters to become early contributors to the program.
